Skate Canada Fee

Every skater must pay the Skate Canada fee every year; in addition to any ice fees. The club you pay this fee to is your home club, i.e., the only club you can test at, for the year. If you have already paid this fee to another club for the 2023 -2024 season, you do not need to pay it to the USC. Please indicate the other club as your "Home Club"

Non-Skating Membership

Skaters who wish to test and/or compete for University Skating Club and are not registered for any USC sessions are required to pay a \$15 USC Administration fee in addition to the Skate Canada fee - \$59.
